Guiding Theses for Discussion and Reflection

- 1) EU-Turkey Relations develop (improve, shape, form) only under the influence of external crises.
- 2) German-Turkish relations are key to the accession process of Turkey to the EU.
- 3) Germany's increasingly assertive role within the EU can only be balanced by a further widening of the EU / by a reform of the EU's institutional architecture.
- 4) Turkey's full EU membership is the only means to ensure Turkey's influence both in its neighbourhood and in Europe.
- 5) The EU-Turkey deal on the management of the refugee crisis has been predominantly shaped and formulated by the European Council.
- 6) The German-French axis is the 'steering wheel' for the EU's common policies.
- 7) Flexible forms of integration are the latest trend in the evolution of the EU system.
- 8) The Turkey-EU dialogue is moving away from Turkey's EU accession process towards the establishment of a strategic partnership.
- 9) The European Parliament is the guardian of EU norms.
- 10) The 'Brexit' opens a window of opportunity for Turkey's integration into the EU.
